



Case Study

Back Pain

76-year-old male. Acute back pain can not stand up straight because of pain, is walking bent over and leaning to his left. He has chronic back pain because of an old injury, this is a flair up and has had this sever pain for about 7 days.

The Story & Emotions

First injured his back when he was in high school while playing basketball he went up for a shot and his friend pulled his feet out from under him and he landed on his back. He has had pain ever sense. 2 months ago, he fell while getting on his bicycle. Broke 3 ribs, while mending from the ribs, he is not able to lay flat or sleep in his bed, and his back started hurting more. He is not able to stand upright and leans to the left. His pain is 9 out of 10.

The Energetic System

Bladder, Gallbladder, Liver

Treatment

He attributes the pain from sleeping in the recliner as his ribs are sore.

Treated GB 34 to GB 67 Both are painful, tight and not moving. No relief from pain.

2nd Treatment

His pain is about the same, not much has change from last treatment.

I treated GB 30 to Gov 3 &4

When he got up off the table he was standing upright. He still had pain but was significantly better

3rd Treatment

He played gulf the day after last session, feels better.

Treated with 3 Spinal Gates. When he left, he was in slightly more pain than when he came in.

4th Treatment

He is still in pain, is able to walk upright but pain is severe.

Result/ How it was resolved

He decided he would go back to his Dr and get an injection.
