

The Person & Complaint

A 53 year old woman was scheduled for a full hysterectomy but was advised that the risk was too high given her haemoglobin count was @ 6 and not increasing; she was also experiencing significant bleeding. That said – because of the ongoing bleeding, not having the operation was also very dangerous. The clear goal was to increase the haemoglobin count as much as possible to allow for the surgery to take place (it would not take place if it stayed at 6). The surgery was only 5 days away (4 days to treat) and nothing tried to date had raised the count above 6 in recent history.

The Story & Emotions

The client was very upset about the fact that her children were now just grown with the final child leaving the house. She was clearly brooding over this issue and refusing to move on to the next natural phase of her life – one that did not have any of her children living with her.

The Energetic System

Netzach and Hod were both blocked and the Spleen organ felt very congested, cold and distressed. Because of the nature of availability and schedules (presenting at a conference) – sessions were required to be spread out within and throughout the 4 days.

Treatment Day 1

- Ren 3: 5 min.
- Netzach: 15 min.
- Spleen/Hod: 60 min.
- Hod only (due to being out in public at restaurant): 15 min.

Treatment Day 2

- Netzach: 45 min.
- Ren 3: 30 min.
- Spleen/Hod: 30 min.

Treatment Day 3

- Netzach: 30 min.
- Spleen/Hod: 45 min.
- Ren 3: 30 min.

Treatment Day 4

- Netzach: 15 min.
- Spleen/Hod: 45 min.

Treatment Summary

Netzach:	1:45 hours
Spleen/Hod:	3:00 hours
Hod only:	0:15 hours
Ren 3:	1:05 hours
<i>Total Treatment Time:</i>	<i>6:05 hours</i>

Important Note

- Each session included talking about the key issue (children leaving the house, moving on to the next phase in life, letting go of the story, etc.) while the treatment was taking place. This conversation notably facilitated a more accepting nature and the positive impact/effect on the treatment areas could be felt in direct connection to stated insights.

Treatment – Resolution & Follow-up

- Notable energy increase during treatment days / bleeding reduction
- Result/Impact: Pre-op haemoglobin test 7.5 (from 6 = up 1.5 points; enough to allow the surgery to take place).
- Successful surgery - full hysterectomy; additional growths also removed for testing / veins addressed/cauterized (which were causing excessive bleeding).
