- I held his head where he had been hit, and did resonance to it. His body twitched like he got electric shocks going through. The area was very hot and very painful.
- Didn't seem much different at the end of the session only laid very still, didn't think there was anything I could do for him

The owner contacted me the following night and said that he seemed a bit better but still very tired. She decided to take him off the pain medication (seemed to make him drowsy) and he just perked up, back to his old self now. Normal energy levels and eye back to normal.
